INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Accepted for publication are original scientific papers or review/monograph type articles related to the thematic scope of the genus *Bison*. All papers will be peer - reviewed.

All manuscripts should be submitted solely in English.

Manuscripts should be sent to the editor only in electronic form.

TEXT EDITING AND LAYOUT

Word processor: Microsoft Word (**absolutely not Open Office**) (ext. doc or docx)

Font: Times New Roman 12 point (except for tables). In tables acceptable are TNR 11 or 10,

Bold - only the title and headings of sub-chapters as well as the author's name

Italic - only taxonomic (*species, genus*) names in Latin

Text: should be left justified, single spaced (insert a blank line between chapters and before tables and figures).

Tables: In Word, the maximum width 150 mm, height 200 mm, each one on a separate page at the end of the text after references. Table heading: Table 1. Title of the table, Citations in the text: (Tabl. 1). Tables should fit an A4-sized page, preferably in portrait.

Figures: Prepared in black and white only, in Corel Draw or in the form of an image file (JPG, TIF or BMP). The maximum dimensions of a figure: width 150 mm, height 200 mm. Each figure should be in a separate file. Figures captions should be included at separate page at the end of the text after tables (Fig. 1. Title of figure ...). Citations in the text: (Fig. 1).

Photos: at least 600 dpi, TIF or JPG format, in separate files, captions in the text – see instruction regarding figures. Photos will be published in black and white version only.

References: chronologically in the text (Smith 1980, Presley, Jones 2002, Lincoln et al. 2014). Alphabetically ordered in References, in case of the same author and the same year identified with letters a, b, c. Citations of papers originally published in the alphabet other than Latin should be translated in accordance with the international standard (ISO Recommendations). Names of journals should be not abbreviated.

LAYOUT OF A SCIENTIFIC PAPER (up to 10 pages of the text + tables and figures)

1. Title
2. Author (s) full name: First name, Initial of the middle name (if applicable), Family name.
3. Affiliation (name of institution, postal address, e-mail address). Each author's affiliation should be identified with letters (a, b, c...) in subscript. Corresponding author should be indicated by *

4. Abstract (200 – 250 words)
5. Keywords (up to 6)
6. Chapters: Introduction, Study area (optional), Materials and Methods, Results Discussion, Acknowledgements
7. References
8. Summary in Polish (for non native Polish authors, the summary will be prepared by the Editor)
